



ACCREDITED FOREST SCHOOL LEADER TRAINING LEVEL 3



What is Forest School?

- It is a long-term process of outdoor learning. Participants take part in regular sessions throughout the year.
- It takes place in a wooded or natural environment.
- It uses a range of learner-centred processes to create a community for development and learning.
- It aims to promote the holistic development of all involved, fostering resilient, confident, independent, and creative learners.
- It offers the learners the opportunity to take supported risks appropriate to the environment and to themselves.
- It is run by qualified Forest School Practitioners, who continuously maintain and develop their professional practice.

Starting on 12th July 2023 Step-Out, Outdoor Learning, Training & Therapy CIC will be running a Forest School Leader course at our HQ Site, Evegate, near Ashford. This Course will run on 12th, 13th, 14th, 17th & 18th July and 18th, 19th & 20th September 2023. It is an AIM accredited Course and the Trainer, Sarah, has been delivering training for more than 12 years.

The course will begin each day at 9.30am and finish by 4.30pm. There is accessible parking and indoor space as well as the private and peaceful woodland for you to hone your skills. On successful completion of the above, an onsite delivery assessment at your own Forest School PLUS attendance at your choice of additional skills sessions and the completion of a portfolio of research and evidence you will be awarded the Level 3 Forest School Leader Certificate. The cost is £950. The accompanying First Aid Course will take place in the same location on the 19th & 20th July and is included in the cost of training.
